Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, December 5, 2017 - On November 22nd, the *Association québécoise de la quincaillerie et des matériaux de construction* (AQMAT) unveiled the ten products nominated for its 2017 Innovation Award. Launched in November 2016, the new SoliFlex[®] flexible corrugated drain with smooth interior wall is nominated for this coveted award that honours an invention, solution or procedure that adds value to the users of its products or services.

The selection criteria that were considered by the AQMAT jury members for the 10 nominated products were: its innovative character, marketing, made-in-Quebec design and manufacturing from a factory located in Quebec, as well as sales potential.

In the week of December 11th, all 850 AQMAT-affiliated merchants, mainly hardware stores and renovation centres, will be asked to express their preferences. From this popular vote, three products will be selected as finalists and the winner will be announced at the AQMAT Recognition Gala to be held on March 3, 2018 in Quebec City.
